You are always at our side.

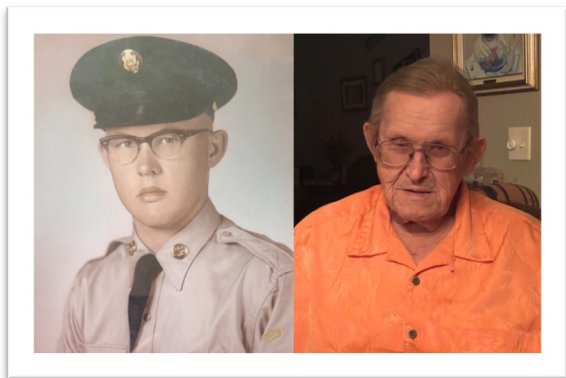
Our family chain is broken,
